## Camp Structure!

- When you drop off your child on their first day of camp, you will receive a Camp Schedule specific to your child's camp theme. This schedule will outline all of the activities for the week, as well as the timings of lunch, breaks, and outdoor activity times.
- Each day is divided into four large time slots, allowing for (in most camps) 4 different hands-on science activities each day!
- Our camp day also includes 45 minutes of outdoor activity time, where campers are encouraged to engage in team-building activities, be active, and socialize!
- Lastly, each day at camp begins with a large science demonstration to get everyone excited for the day's experiments!

*Our goal is to strike a balance between academic, social and recreational pursuits.*

## Drop-Off and Pick-Up

Regular morning drop-off time is 8:50 – 9:00. If your child is attending our Pre-Camp Program, they are to be dropped off at 8:00am.

Look for ClubScientific signs directing you to the appropriate entrance for your camp facility. Each location will have a registration table for sign-in. Make sure that you receive your unique ID# and pick up a copy of the Activity Schedule for your child's themed camp.

If your child must leave early, please notify the Site Director of this in writing!

Please pick your child up promptly at 4:00pm, unless he or she is attending the Post-Camp Program.



Note: Any pickup past 5:30 will be charged \$1/minute.



## For Campers:

Inappropriate language will NOT be permitted.

Fighting, teasing, bullying or any intimidation by anyone is strictly prohibited -- and is cause for dismissal from camp.

Good sportsmanship is always expected.

Please leave all cell phones at home, as campers are not allowed to use them during camp.

Campers are encouraged to wear their camp T-shirt each day!

Campers are expected to treat each other, the staff and the facility with respect.

Tipping at our Summer Camps is strictly prohibited! Instead, our staff members can earn performance bonuses based on evaluations completed by you and their Site Directors.

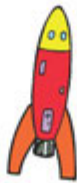

## It's all about your camper's Health and Safety

In order for our Site Directors to administer medication to your child at any time during camp, you and your child's physician **MUST** complete the "Authorization of Medication" form.



Medication must be sent to camp in its original bottle. The medical authorization form, along with several others, can be downloaded from our website.

If your child is ill and will not be attending camp, please notify the [ClubScientific](#) main office.

Please do **NOT** send your child to camp if he/she is not feeling well.

If your child becomes ill during camp, we will use the emergency contact numbers you have provided.

Anytime you are visiting the camp, please have your child's ID number and enter the main entrance of the building.

Remember that parents are **NOT** permitted beyond the registration table. The only exception is on Fridays during Family Day, when all parents are invited to come visit their children's classrooms and instructors.

Campers must bring their own lunch, drinks and snacks each day. Please do **NOT** send items that must be heated in the microwave oven. Also, we do **NOT** have refrigeration at most locations, so a cold pack included in the lunch box is a good idea.



Due to food allergy concerns, please refrain from packing peanut butter or other nut products.
